### **Property and Area Description**

University District serving the University of Illinois campus (enrollment at 50,000), Midtown Plaza is a two building development which includes first floor retail/office space. The location benefits from strong vehicular and pedestrian traffic while being situated among many new residential developments serving the student population as well as the greater community. The First Street Corridor has seen seen tremendous growth in both residential and retail developments over the past three years. Delivered to tenant with following improvements: Plumbing roughed for one restroom, 200 amp electrical service, concrete floor, HVAC unit sized for standard retail/office use (no distribution), demising wall taped, mudded, and ready for tenant finish. Building Highlights: Two, five story buildings constructed in 2018, 104 residential apartments on floors 2 through 5 with total of 180 beds, apartment tenancy includes students, professionals, UI faculty, etc., public plaza area between the two buildings providing access to the Boneyard Second Street Basin, 50 parking spaces available immediate adjacent to retail/office space for customer parking, underground parking for tenants use, additional parking available on west side of first street (map to be included), available spaces can be demised, large windows facing both front of building (west side) as well as the east side of building providing tremendous views of Boneyard Parkway, fiber from 3 major IT providers, zoned: CB (Central Business).
