Property and Area Description

This site is located on the Burlington Northern Santa Fe (BNSF) Main line near the U.S. Highway 6 & 34 and Nebraska Highway 44 intersection. Interstate 80 is 13 miles north of the site via Highway 44. KAAPA Ethanol LLC currently conducts their operations with two railroad switches on the BNSF which runs directly on the north side of their facility. These existing rail switches and KAAPA's internal loop track provides the potential for rail access to the site. KAAPA Ethanol LLC operates their own water (two wells) and wastewater system. New water users in the region may be required to offset any new use. Southern Power District is the electric provider and is experienced in serving industrial loads. Natural gas is provided by Northwestern Energy. The site is currently outside the city limits of Minden but the KAAPA Ethanol plant was annexed into Minden for tax increment financing (TIF) advantages. The possibility exists for future development.
